GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Inventory Control Supervisor is responsible for the adequacy of inventories within the organizations distribution system as well as monitoring the productivity of their assigned team.

SPECIFIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Inventory Control Supervisor should have a good understanding of warehousing procedures and a keen sense for attention to details. Responsible include:

- Follow service standards and complying with procedures, rules and regulations
- Maintaining a clean and safe working environment
- Responsible for the supervision, training, and development of the receiving and inventory control teams.
- Executes daily inventory analysis; identifies and resolves discrepancies and problems.
- Oversees stock item master, identifying incorrect descriptions and stock numbers.
- Locates items that may have incorrect locations or stock numbers to assist order processors.
- Communicates information as needed regarding new items, changes of location, counts, etc.
- Provide ownership and control of the sites repair parts storage and repair processes.
- Ensures milestones and goals are met.
- Ensures adherence to approved budget.
- Operates forklift as needed.

Assigned other tasks from time to time by supervisor as deemed necessary.
